Cleveland School District Stakeholder Meetings**

**Stakeholder meetings are offered as a part of the Mississippi School Boards Association Superintendent Search Service. Involving the stakeholders in the superintendent search process allows for feedback on the characteristics desired in the new superintendent, on the priorities which the new superintendent should address, and on how to define success for the new superintendent at the end of the first year. The board members will use the stakeholder feedback to develop interview questions for the applicants and as a foundation for making the decision as to who will be the new superintendent.**

**There are two opportunities for stakeholders to provide feedback. The first opportunity is provided by attending a face-to-face stakeholder meeting. These meetings are conducted by the MSBA Superintendent Search Consultant and the MSBA Assistant Executive Director to explain the search process and to gather input from the stakeholders. Paper surveys are distributed at the meeting and oral responses are scripted. Responses from the meetings are compiled and included in a stakeholder report to the board members.**

**The second opportunity is provided through an online survey posted at the MSBA & CSD websites. The survey can be accessed by any stakeholder and is anonymous. The results of the online stakeholder feedback are compiled and included in a stakeholder report to the board members.**

**There will be three face-to-face meetings in the Cleveland Central High School Auditorium. All stakeholder meetings will take place on January 22, 2019.**

- Parents and community members will meet from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m.**
