TOPS

Gold polo/shirt, red polo/shirt, navy polo/shirt, and white button down shirt

Vests and/or cardigans (button down sweaters) may be worn

(shirts may be button down but **must** have a collar)

ABSOLUTELY NO WHITE POLO SHIRTS!!!

(For the cooler weather months, collared long sleeve shirts, such as a long sleeve polo or button down, are allowed.)

BOTTOMS

Khaki bottom, Navy bottom, or uniform plaid with navy, white, gold, and red bottom
(Appropriate types of bottoms are long pants, shorts, capris, skirts, skorts, and jumpers.)

*Due to students participating in physical education activities, only closed-toe shoes should be worn. **No flip-flops at any time.**

*All students should remain within this required dress code. Dress code attire may be worn on any day throughout the week. No specific color is required for any specific day. Violation of the dress code will result in the student calling home for a change of clothes, detention, and/or being sent home. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

IMPORTANT CHANGES:

- 1) Every Friday will be “*Nailor Spirit Day*”. On Fridays, students may wear a *Nailor shirt or dress code shirt with jeans*. If the student comes with any other attire on or another type of shirt, he/she will call home for their regular dress code attire.. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!**

OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS FROM THE CLEVELAND SCHOOL DISTRICT HANDBOOK



- Students **must** wear a belt if belt loops are visible.
- No mini skirts or shorts; Shorts and skirts must be worn no more than 3 to 4 inches above top of knee.
- No flip-flops or house shoes.
- No sagging pants.
- All shirts must be tucked in at all times (girls and boys).
- Leggings may be worn appropriately under skirts, skorts, and/or jumpers. Leggings may not be worn as pants alone.
