



## Guidance for the Read-aloud and Calculator Accommodations on the MAP

Guidance for the **Read-aloud Accommodations** on the MAP for Students with an Individualized Education Program (IEP), Section 504 Plan, and Language Service Plan (LSP) who have this testing accommodation specified for this subject area

### ELA/English II

- A53 - For grades 3-8 and English II, the directions can be read to the students throughout the assessment.
- A55 and A58 – For grades 3-8 and English II, the directions and the questions and answer choices can be read aloud, but the reading passages cannot be read to the student. **Beginning with the 2016-2017 academic year, the read-aloud accommodation will be non-allowable for students in third grade.**

### Math/Algebra I

- A53 - For grades 3-8 and Algebra I, the directions can be read to the students throughout the assessment.
- A55 and A58 – For grades 3-8 and Algebra I, the directions and the questions and answer choices can be read aloud to the student.

Guidance for the **Calculator Accommodation** on the MAP for Students with an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Section 504 Plan who have this testing accommodation specified for this subject area

### Math/Algebra I

- A61 - For grades 3-5, a calculator is not used for the assessment.
- A61 – For grades 6-8 and Algebra I, the approved type of calculator can be used; however, if any section prohibits the use of a calculator, then a basic four-function calculator could be used in those sections.
