Image-based navigation helps young readers navigate through stories, games, videos, and interactive coloring pages for educational entertainment.



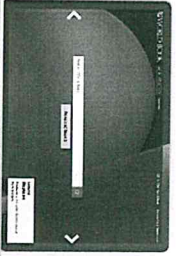
Ages 6-10

Ages 14 and up

Travel tips to navigate World Book Online:

Color Within *Early Learning*

- Select the Activities button on the homepage or within the header on any other page
- Choose the red paintbrush icon to get to the Coloring category



- Select an activity to open it up in the paint application, and color away!
- Save/print the colored activity by choosing the camera icon to download the PDF.

Save an Article on Kids to Reference Later

- Go to any Kids article and select the tools icon in the top right corner
- Select download and open the downloaded PDF in your preferred reader

Using Citation Builder in *Student* or *Advanced*

- Select Citation Builder from the homepage
- Select the type of citation you want to build (e.g., book, article, video, etc.)
- Complete the requested fields as best you can, then choose Create Citation
- Download, email, or print the citation that is created in MLA, APA, and Harvard for your use

Using My Research in *Student* or *Advanced*

- You will need to log in to an existing My Research account or create a new My Research account
- Once you have logged in, users can save any World Book article or media to a My Research project. To do so:
 - > Select Tools

> Choose Save, then use the drop-down menu to save to an existing My Research Project or save to a new project

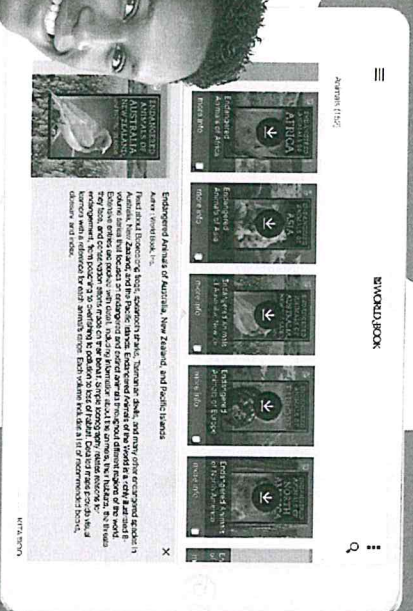
- Add websites to your list of resources to keep all of your reference materials in one place
- You can delete or annotate any entries you include under a project
- You can toggle between projects by selecting Switch Projects
- Rename, delete, or create projects using the icons across the top

Using Pathfinders in *Advanced*

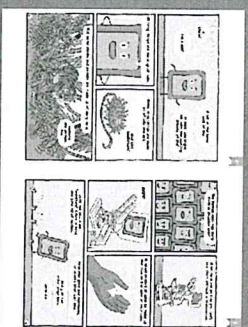
- Navigate to the project you would like to share and choose "Create Pathfinder"
- Select if you would like the Pathfinder to be shared and optionally sign your Pathfinder with your name and grade level
